DETAILS

Combining national guidance (DfE, EEF, NCETM) with local specialist knowledge, the programme will discuss and provide practical strategies for supporting:

- General Maths Difficulties including Dyscalculia
- Language difficulties in Maths
- Memory and attention difficulties
- Maths Anxiety and Confidence

The programme will follow a structure to implement a graduated response (Assess, Plan, Do, Review) for a case study pupil.
